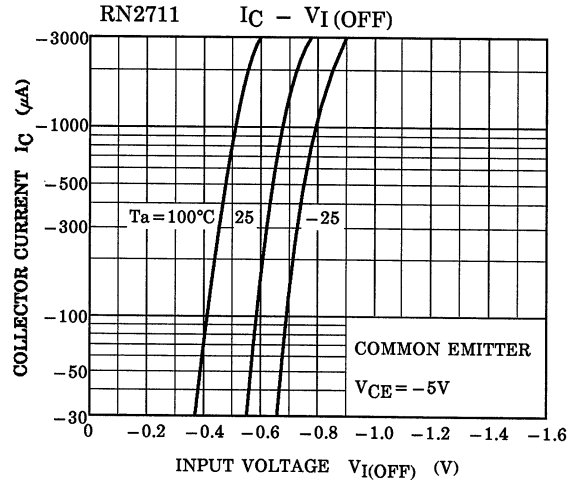
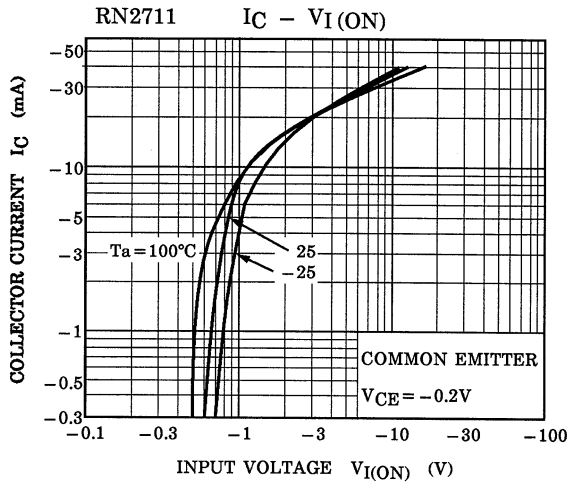
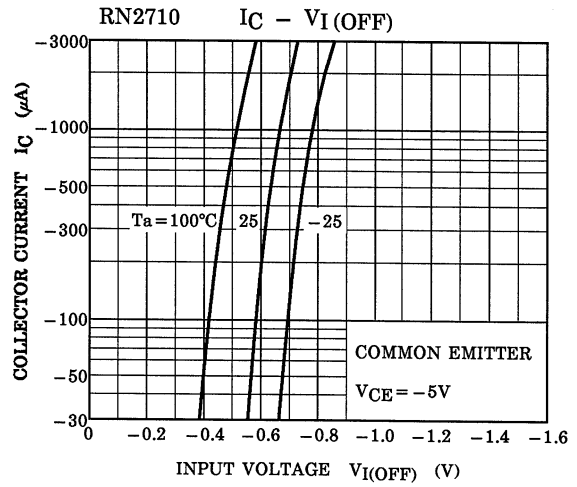
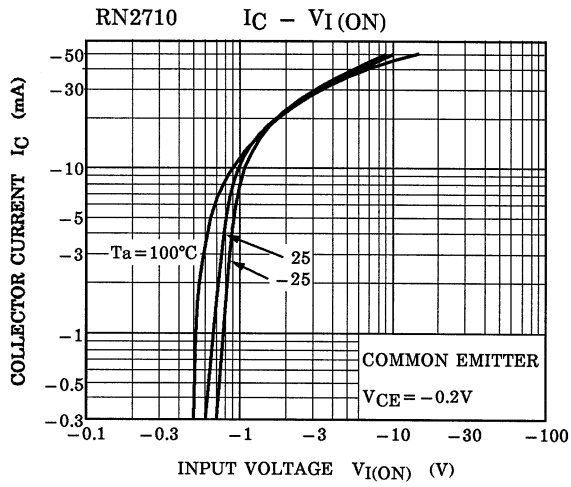
Equivalent Circuit (Top View)



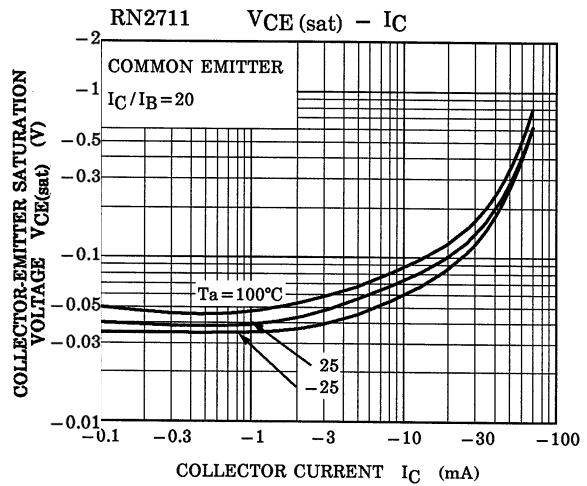
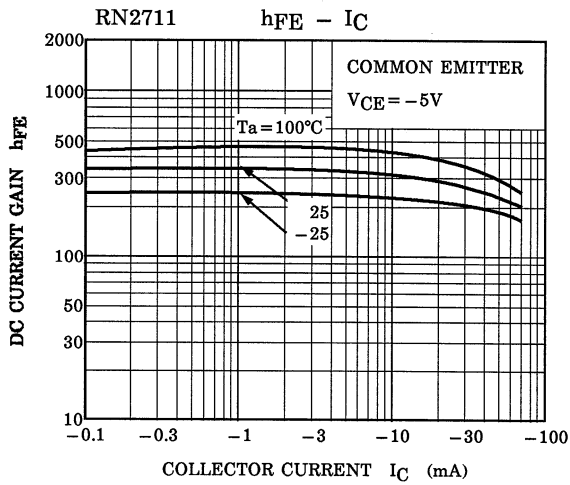
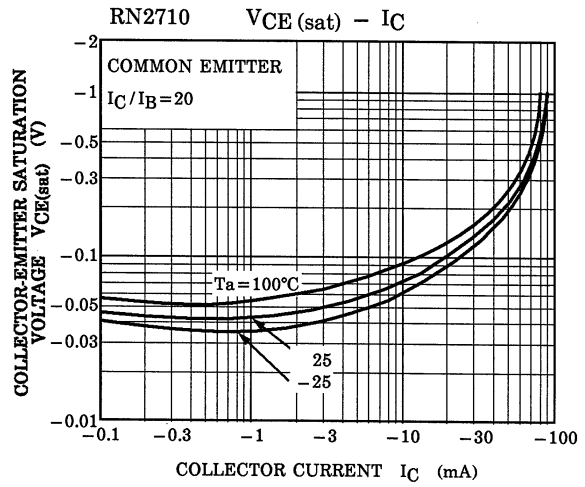
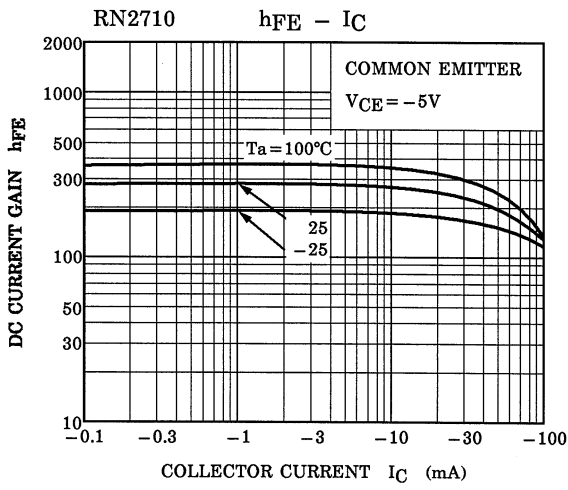

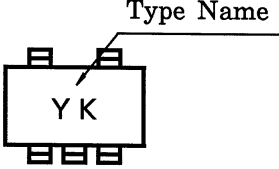
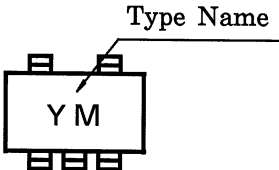
Q1, Q2 Common
