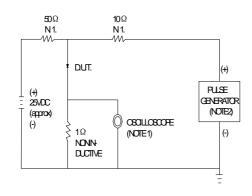

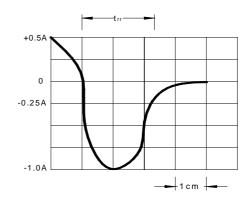
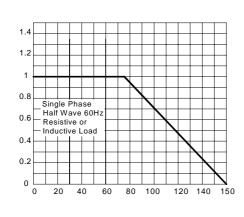
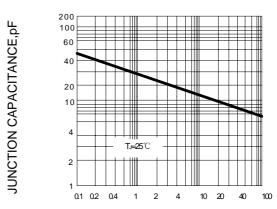


FIG.3 -FORWARD DERATING CURVE

FIG.4-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE



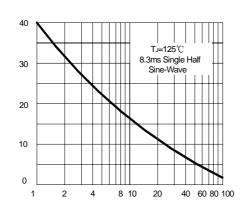


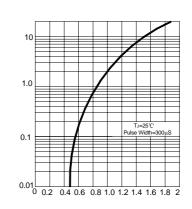
AMBIENT TEMPERATURE. °C
